



RELEASE, WAIVER, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT for the Canadian National Trapshooting Championships and Alberta International Trapshooting Provincial Championships
 In consideration of being permitted to engage in clay target shooting, and all associated activities including transportation by 563386 ALBERTA LTD o/a BEAVERHILL SPORTING CLAYS (hereinafter referred to as the Releasees),

I, _____ on behalf of myself, my personal representations, heirs and next of kin, acknowledge and agree that:

1. Sporting Clays and activities related thereto including transportation, involve inherent risks dangers and hazards, and I freely accept and fully assume all such risks, dangers and hazards and accept the possibility of personal injury, death or property damage or loss resulting therefrom.
2. I hereby release the Releasees, their employees, agents, officers, and contractors, from any and all liability for loss, damage or injuries which may be suffered by me, including any liability arising from negligence of the Releasees, employees, agents, officers, members, volunteers, directors or contractors.
3. I further agree that the Releasees shall not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury suffered by me while participating in any activity using any facilities or being transported to or from any activities related to shooting for any reason whatsoever.
4. This Release, Waiver, and Indemnity Agreement, is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted within the laws of the Province of Alberta. This Agreement shall be governed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Province of Alberta and any action involving the parties to this Agreement shall be brought only within the Province of Alberta. This Release includes a Release including any statutory or other duty of care including any duty of care under the Occupiers Liability Act R.S.A. 1980, c 0-3.
5. I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS AGREEMENT. THIS DOCUMENT MEANS THAT I AM WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE WHICH I, MY HEIRS, NEXT OF KIN, EXECUTORS, OR REPRESENTATIVES MAY HAVE AGAINST THE RELEASEES AND THEIR EMPLOYEES, REPRESENTATIVES, OFFICERS, AGENTS OR CONTRACTORS.

6. I agree to adhere to the rules as set out by 563386 ALBERTA LTD o/a BEAVERHILL SPORTING CLAYS as listed below:

- Property access for the Canadian National Trapshooting Championships and Alberta International Trapshooting Provincial Championships is only permitted August 4-12th during times identified in the schedule
- All shooters must adhere to and abide by the Canadian (Federal Government) firearms laws and regulations
- A minor (anyone under 18 years old) must have their parent or legal guardian co - sign their liability waiver AND must be under the direct supervision of a responsible adult who possesses a valid PAL license, and must be with that adult at all times while on the facility.
- Gun safety to be practiced by all members at all times
- Hearing and Eye Protection Mandatory
- Appropriate footwear is required (NO open toed Shoes) Hats Recommended
- ONLY SHOTGUNS ALLOWED on the property
- Tactical shotguns are expressly prohibited
- Gun Barrel length must be greater than 24 inches
- Shell Shot size allowed is no larger than 7 1/2's (7 1/2, 8's, 9's Only) and maximum load is 1 1/8 oz. NO HUNTING LOADS ALLOWED
- Max shells allowed in firearm is two (2)
- You are not permitted to shoot any other sport but International Trap unless you obtain permission of the organization and are accompanied by a BHSC member
- You must carry liability insurance from the Shooting Federation of Canada or pay a fee to obtain a day membership with BHSC
- If shooting sporting clays Shooting stands to be used at all times. No moving of Stand or Swing Arms Allowed
- Guns are to be loaded and unloaded only when thru the shooting window or while on the shooting line as per the ISSF rules.
- Actions must be open when leaving shooting stands or International Trap shooting platform
- Break-action shotguns may be closed while in gun racks, gun cases or in carts, but must be unloaded
- All other shotguns in gun racks, gun cases or in carts must be unloaded and the action will remain open
- As regulated by NSCA the use of horizontal gun racks or horizontal gun cases are not permitted until leaving the facility.
- Return the I-Pull controller to the holder (sporting clays field).
- Pick up and dispose of your empty shell casings in the garbage provided.
- No Dogs Allowed on The Course
- No driving on the course with vehicles
- Golf carts & ATV's are allowed and must stay on the pathways. Maximum speed 10 km
- Golf Carts rented from Beaverhill Sporting Clays have a 2-person maximum limit
- NO ALCOHOL OR CANNABIS consumption OR usage on the property or prior to shooting
- Any unsportsmanlike conduct or any behaviour which may adversely impact the safety of any individual or the range may result in the immediate removal of the offender and their entire party from the property
- Beaverhill Sporting Clays and its management has the right to revoke access/membership at the company's full discretion with no remuneration
- I fully understand that live ammunition is being fired on the property and I use the facility at my own risk
- Beaverhill Sporting Clays is not responsible for any accident, injury or damage to your person or personal property incurred while using these premises
