

#### **PART: A GENERAL**

#### **ISSF Code of Ethics**

In accordance with the ISSF Constitution, the objectives of the ISSF are to promote and encourage the development of the shooting sport throughout the world, to provide drug-free sport and to promote and encourage the development of international relations. The purpose of this Code is to guarantee that the objectives of the ISSF will be executed in a fair manner without disturbance and to sanction incidents that damage the image of the ISSF activities or bring them into disrepute. ISSF members, continental organizations, teams, officials and athletes shall participate in ISSF Championships and activities in accordance with the standards of ethics, fair play and sportsmanship established by the ISSF Statutes, Rules and Regulations and by this Code. This Code recognizes basic standards for fair play and moral behavior and procedures for judging and sanctioning violations of those standards.

#### APPLICATION OF THE CODE

The following incidents or offences shall be subject to the application of this Code:

- 1.1 Acts of discrimination in violation of the Constitution of the ISSF.
- 1.2 Acts of misconduct, misbehaviour or harassment including, but not limited to abusive, violent conduct in a disturbing, disorderly or provocative manner, unjustified interference, deliberate obstruction of the orderly conduct of any sporting event, malicious alteration, damage or destruction of property or the infliction of physical or mental harm on others.
- 1.3 Cheating including, but not limited to doping, manipulation of equipment or scores to give an advantage to an athlete or to a team, falsification or alteration of documents indicating false age, nationality, gender or other information, with the purpose of obtaining unfair advantage for an official, an athlete or a team.
- 1.4 Conviction for a criminal offence.
- 1.5 Acts of indiscretion, insubordination or partiality.
- 1.6 Ethical offences may be considered independent of any action

Behavior issues: Please be aware that the organizing committee will not tolerate any abuse of any kind of our volunteers, officials or competitors. If the organizing committee determines that such abuse has occurred or that the ISSF Code of Ethics has been breached, the organizing committee will eject any individual responsible for such abuse. The individual will be ejected from any venue utilized by the National Championship.

- d. All shooting events in this competition are registered with the Shooting Federation of Canada (SFC) and will be conducted in accordance with ISSF and SFC rules. The match committee reserves the right to modify the rules, procedures and times dependent upon range conditions and local circumstances.
- e. All participants who reside in Canada must be members of the Shooting Federation of Canada.
- f. An Officials Training Clinic will commence Monday, July 9 (1400- 1600), prior to the commencement of the Championships and a practical portion will continue each day of the competition.
- g. The facilities are wheelchair accessible. All firing line and access surfaces are either concrete or graveled at the Camrose Range or the Camrose Regional Exhibition, air-gun venue. Movement from the parking lots to the venue ranges are flat surfaces.
- h. The Statistics and Registration Office will be located in the Camrose Shooting Sports Association range from July 9-14, 2023, and will move to the Camrose Regional Exhibition July 14-16, 2023
- i. The Equipment Control Office and Equipment display areas will be located in the Camrose Shooting Sports Association clubhouse from July 10-14, 2023 and move to the Camrose Regional Exhibition July 14-16, 2023.
  - j. The current ISSF Rule book will be used by all range staff. Protest fee will be \$50.00.
  - k. Anti-doping controls may be conducted at this National Championship
- 2: Shooting Federation of Canada Shooting Team

The 2023 National Pistol Championships will serve as a qualifying competition for the Shooting Federation of Canada's National Pistol Team (see part G)

#### PART: B REGISTRATION AND APPLICATION

#### 1: REGISTRATION

- a. Proof of SFC membership is required at the time of registration. You will be required to have an SFC number before registering. If you require an SFC membership, please contact the SFC directly (sfc-ftc.ca). Membership will **not** be available for purchase in-person at the event.
- b. Non-residents of Canada must be members of their National Shooting Association, and will be required to show a current classification document to be classified anything below Master for the purposes of this competition. Those who are not Canadian citizens must show proof of Canadian covered insurance or purchase an SFC membership with insurance included.
- c. Competitors will be required to complete a registration card during the registration process, and indicate their classification for each event in which they are competing. After fully registering and completing the signature cards, the classification level submitted by the competitor will stand unless the Match Jury deems a change is required. IF a competitor knowingly registers in a class that is below their actual class and does not take steps to rectify the issue, the competitor will be disqualified for falsification of documents and no refund will be offered for fees remitted.
- d. No post or on-site entries will be accepted.

#### 2: VISITOR'S AUTHORIZATION TO TRANSPORT PERMITS

 a. Competitors who are not residents of Canada are required to obtain an authorization to transport permit for their firearms, to enter and travel inside Canada.

b. You will be required to provide your point-of- entry into Canada, arrival date, departure date and your expected residential address during your stay. The following information will be needed for each firearm: caliber, barrel length, serial number and magazine or cylinder capacities, as applicable.

#### PART: C COMPETITION INFORMATION

#### 1. COMPETITOR INFORMATION

- a. Participation in these Championships is open. However, only Canadian citizens are eligible to be named the "Canadian Champion" in any event. Proof of citizenship may be required for those registrants for the National Team. Non-Canadians will be eligible for "High Visitor" awards only. All competitors without an SFC verified classification, will shoot only for Match Winner or "High Visitor", as the case may be.
- b. Only Canadian citizens are eligible to shoot finals in the appropriate events.
- c. Each competitor will be asked to sign a Freedom of Information release which will allow the competitor's name to be published with the results sheets.
- d. ALL competitors in the 25m Pistol, 25 m Rapid Fire Pistol and 10m pistol events will fire TWICE over the course, except for disabled or supported competitors.

#### 2. ENTRY

- a. Entry forms must be filled out online at <a href="www.match-planning.com">www.match-planning.com</a> no entries by mail will be accepted.
- b. Schedule is attached.

c. Early entries are encouraged and necessary to facilitate squadding and planning in general.

- Any entry received before May 1, 2023 will be entered for a prize package courtesy of Korth Group.
- Registration will be cut off after June 20, 2023. No further entries will be accepted after this date.
- d. Extra positions and/or will not be added after May 1, 2023.
- e. Valid classes include: Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, Veteran, International Junior, Junior, Sub-junior, and disabled classes as declared valid by the SFC. All classes male and female are considered as valid.
- f. VETERANS class are those 55 years of age or older. Those competitors who have the age qualification may register in the Veterans class or in their regular class, but not both, and will shoot in all events either as a veteran or in their regular class.

#### 3. AWARDS

All awards will be standard medals.

4. SMOKING/VAPING/CANNABIS AND/OR SUBSTANCE USE

Smoking and/or vaping is not permitted in any range, stats or scoring offices, any other closed room or tent, OR on any of the firing lines. If you must smoke or vape please do so away from any crowds in the parking lot.

Alcoholic beverages, cannabis use of any kind and/or any illegal substance use is not permitted on the premises at all.

#### THE DISCIPLINES: ALL EVENTS ARE OPEN TO SFC MEMBERS AND VISITORS

- a. All competitions are registered with the SFC. Match ID number:
- b. ISSF regulation 3.1, 3.2.1, 3.2.4, 3.2.4, 3.3 and 2007 Section meeting determination, those competitions with team trials/finals are not open gender events. The following matches are restricted to males: 25m Raid Fire Pistol and 10m Pistol Men. The following matches are restricted to women: 25m Pistol and 10m Pistol Women.
- c. Match designation: and specifics of competition
  - i. <u>25 m Pistol Women</u>: competition will take place at the Camrose Shooting Sports Association Range. There will be 10 shooting positions with 1 relay per shooting day. **MAXIMUM**NUMBER OF COMPETITORS: 10.
    - a. 60 competition shots per competition
    - b. Megalink electronic scoring will be used
    - c. Each competitor will fire two complete matches over two days. Disabled competitors will fire once over the course
    - d. In compliance with rule: 8.7.6.4 sub e), all competitors will complete the precision stage before the rapid fire stage commences.
    - e. Athletes will be called to the line 13 minutes before START time. Athletes will be have 3 minutes of Prepartion time before a 5 min sighting time.
    - f. Finals will be comprised of the top 8 athletes who will fire two preliminary matches followed by 4 athlete Medal Match.
    - g. awards: only Canadian citizens will advance to the finals.
    - h. Current ISSF rules will apply.
  - ii. <u>25 m Rapid Fire Men</u>: will be fired on the Camrose Shooting Sports Association Range MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS: 3 PER RELAY AND 3 RELAYS for a total of 9 athletes.
    - a. 60 competition shots to be completed in two halves of 30 shots per half course
    - b. Megalink electronic scoring will be used.
    - c. Each competitor will fire two complete courses over two days. Disabled competitors will fire once over the course.
    - d. Athletes will be called to the line 13 minutes before START time. Athletes will have 5 minutes to setup equipment, followed by 3 minutes of Preparation time before 1 sighting series in 8 seconds.
    - e. Finals will consist of the top 8 athletes shooting two preliminary matches followed by a 4 athlete Medal Match.
    - f. awards: only Canadian citizens will advance to the finals.
    - g. Current ISSF rules will apply

- iii. <u>10 m Pistol (Air Pistol)</u>: to be fired at the Camrose Regional Exhibition **MAXIMUM NUMBER**OF COMPETITORS: 30 PER RELAY AND 2 RELAYS
  - a. 60 competition shot match for both men and women, 30 competition shots for supported shooters
  - b. Megalink Electronic targets will be used
  - c. each competitor will fire two complete matches: AWAD will fire once over the course.
  - d. competition is open to male, female and juniors
  - e. Athletes will be allowed to setup their equipment 20 minutes before START time. Athletes will have 15 minutes of Preparation and Sighting Time.
  - f. Finals will be completed for males, females,
  - g. Final will consist of the top 8 athletes shooting elimination series with the gold / silver medals decided by face to face shoot off.
  - h. Awards: only Canadian citizens will advance to the finals.
  - i. Current ISSF rules will apply.
- iv. <u>50m Pistol</u>: To be fired at the Camrose Shooting Sports Association Range **MAXIMUM** NUMBER OF COMPETITORS: 10
  - a. Fired on the 50 m range.
  - b. Megalink 50m electronic targets will be used
  - c. 60 shots in 1.5 hour time limit.
  - d. All Competitors will fire one complete match.
  - e. Athletes may put their equipment on the firing line 20 minutes before START. Athletes will have 15 minutes of Preparation and Sighting time.
  - f. Sighting shots allowed in the time period assigned
  - g. no more than 60 record shots in the competition
  - h. no more than 1.5 hours of competition time unless unusual circumstances as determined by the CRO.
  - i. awards: only Canadian citizens are eligible for Canadian Champion
  - j. Current ISSF rules will apply.
- v. <u>25 m Standard Pistol</u>: this event will be fired on the Camrose Shooting Sports Association Range MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS: 10
  - a. 60 competition shots
  - b. Megalink Electronic scoring will be used
  - c. Gender: open, SFC classes will be used
  - d. Athletes may put their equipment on the firing line 13 minutes before START. Athletes will be allowed 3 minutes Preparation Time followed by a Sighting Series of 150 seconds.
  - e. awards: only Canadian citizens are eligible for Canadian Champion
- vi. <u>25 m Centre Fire Pistol</u>: this event will be fired at the Camrose Shooting Sports Association Range MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS: 10
  - a. 60 competition shots divided into 30 precision and 30 rapid fire
  - b. Megalink Electronic scoring will be used

- c. In compliance with rule: 8.7.6.4 sub 5 all competitors will complete the precision stage before the rapid fire stage commences.
- d. Athletes will be allowed to put their equipment on the firing line 13 minutes before START. Athletes will be allowed 3 minutes of Preparation time, followed by Sighting time of 5 minutes.
- e. gender: open, SFC classes will be used
- f. awards: only Canadian citizens are eligible for Canadian Champion
- vii. <u>CISM Military Rapid Fire</u>: this event will be fired at the Camrose Shooting Sports Association Range MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS: 10
  - a. 60 competition shots divided into 30 precision and 30 rapid fire
  - b. Megalink Electronic scoring will be used
  - c. gender: : open, SFC classes will be used
  - d. Athletes will be allowed to put their equipment on the firing line 13 minutes before START. Athletes will be allowed 3 minutes of Preparation time, followed by Sighting time of five shots in 10 seconds.
  - e. awards: only Canadian citizens are eligible for Canadian Champion
- viii. <u>10m Air Pistol Mixed Team:</u> to be fired at the Camrose Recreation Centre **MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS**: 30 PER RELAY AND 2 RELAYS
  - a. 30 competition shot match for each team member in 30 minutes
  - b. Megalink Electronic targets will be used
  - c. each competitor will fire one complete match
  - d. competition is open to male, female, juniors and AWAD.
  - e. Athletes will be allowed to setup their equipment 20 minutes before START. Athletes will have 15 minutes of Preparation and Sighting Time before START.
  - f. Finals will be completed
  - g. awards: only Canadian citizens will advance to the finals.
  - h. Current ISSF rules will apply.
- ix. **25 m Rapid Fire Mixed Team**: will be fired on the Camrose Shooting Sports Association Range **MAXIMUM NUMBER OF TEAM:** PER RELAY AND 3 RELAYS
  - a. 30 competition shots to be completed by each teammate

  - c. Each competitor will fire one complete courses of 30 shots.

  - d. Athletes will be allowed to put equipment on the firing line 8 minutes before START. Athletes will have 3 minutes of Preparation Time, followed by a sighter series in 8 seconds.

# Special notice of withdrawal given to athlete to withdraw from competition as authorised by Match Committee:

In the event that a competitor's fired shot(s) hit the electronic scoring target protection plate, the following penalty sequence shall be followed:

: first occurrence: YELLOW card ..... warning issued

: second occurrence: GREEN card ... 2 point penalty assigned

: third occurrence: RED card ... disqualification due to unsafe shooting. The score that has been fired for record will be entered into the record sheets. No refund will be offered to the competitor.

In order for scores to be eligible athletes must submit a QSDR <a href="form">form</a> to the High Performance <a href="portal">portal</a> by June 11, 2023.

The 2023 Canadian National Pistol Championships are also a qualifying event for both the 2023 Pan Am Games and 2024 Pan Am Championships. Both events are Paris 2024 Olympic qualifying events.
