Check-in

Please check-in at the **Registration Desk** at the range, prior to shooting, on the days and at the times noted on site. Competitor bib numbers will be supplied at registration.

Mixed Team Event (Included in Registration Fee):

The 2-Person Mixed Team Event will be determined following the first 125 targets. This is a fun event at no additional cost. Teams will be formed by pairing the highest-scoring Canadian men with the lowest-scoring Canadian women to create the maximum number of balanced teams. Final team standings will be based on the combined scores of both athletes over 250 targets each, for a total team score out of 500.

6. SFC Membership

All competitors **MUST** be current members in good standing of the Shooting Federation of Canada or become a member and be able to provide proof of membership. **Membership is required to register.**

7. Rules and Regulations

The 2026 Canadian International Trap Championships will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules and Regulations, currently posted on the ISSF website at www.issf-sports.org. It is the responsibility of the athletes and coaches to be familiar with the current ISSF rules.

The Jury reserves the right to make exceptions to the Rules, procedures and times as and when necessary (e.g.: finals format). All changes will be announced and posted at the range. The Chief Referee will coordinate with the match director to select an appropriate number of jury members.

All shooters are expected to serve as sideline referees or flankers. If an athlete is scheduled to shoot the next round, immediately following flanking duty, there will be at least a 20 minute break between flanking and shooting. If an athlete fails to act as a sideline referee when he/she is required to do so, they shall be penalized as per the ISSF Rules.

An up-to-date program schedule (with changes to time or added information) will be posted on site.

Junior Category (ISSF General Regulations, Rule 3.7.4.12).

Athletes will remain as Juniors until the 31st of December of the year in which they become 21

years of age.

Master category (Canadian Definition)

Athletes must be at least 55 years old on or before the beginning of competition.

For Transgender athletes please see the SFC Transgender policy.

Equipment control may be conducted following the ISSF Rules and Regulations (9.4.1) using approved instruments.

Targets: The Trap range is equipped with international orange targets supplied by an ISSF-approved manufacturer (e.g., Eurotarget or Laporte).

Protests: Warnings/penalties will be given according to the current ISSF Official Statutes, Rules and Regulations. Protest forms will be available at the Chief Referee's desk.

Protests will be handled by the Jury. Cost is \$50.00 each. The Jury's decisions are final.

Finals: A decision will be made and circulated on the SFC Website by June 15th regarding which ISSF Rules will be in place for the finals. Dependent on the availability of necessary technology will determine the ISSF rules effective January 1st 2026 or from previous to that date.

Only Canadian citizens or Permanent Residents with proof of intent to obtain Canadian citizenship will be eligible to compete in Finals. Juniors will be included in the Finals of any event in which they qualify.

Safety

All pertinent firearms safety practices will be observed. Failure to follow safety rules or direction from Officials or Jury may be cause for disqualification and/or removal.

Eye protection and ear protection are mandatory for all competitors and officials on ranges while shooting is in progress. Any medical emergencies should be immediately reported to a range official.

Spectators, visitors and coaches must follow and adhere to all safety instructions from officials, range safety officers and facility staff. Failure to comply with safety requirements may result in removal from the facility. The TITSCL, OOTA, Organizing Committee and the Shooting Federation of Canada will not be responsible for any articles lost or stolen or any article left at the range during the competition.

Dress Code

All competitors, officials, coaches, volunteers and any other parties involved in this event must adhere to the ISSF Dress Code policy. **Prohibited clothing items include** blue jeans, camouflage clothing, sleeveless T-shirts, ragged cut-off shorts, all types of sandals, as well as shirts or trousers with non-sporting or inappropriate messages.

Anti-doping Controls

Athletes, and officials may be subject to anti-doping controls conducted by the Canadian Centre for Drug-free Sport in accordance with ISSF and International Olympic Committee anti-doping regulations. SFC Code of Conduct and Ethics

All competitors, coaches, officials, volunteers and any other parties involved in this event must adhere to the SFC Code of Conduct & Ethics.

SFC contracts with ITP Sport to act as the Independent Third Party for shooting in Canada should any concerns arise. Please see the Safe Sport page on the SFC website for more information.

Smoking

Smoking is not permitted at any range, any other closed room or tent, OR on any of the firing lines. There is no smoking in any spectator areas. Smokers are asked to move away from any people when requested. Smoking is only permitted in the parking lot and isolated areas away from others, and away from the onsite propane tank. These rules apply to vaping as well.

9. Awards - 2026 Canadian International Trapshooting Championships

Only one (1) award per athlete can be awarded. In a situation where an athlete qualifies for more than one (1) award, the highest placing will be awarded to the athlete.

All awards will be presented after the competition has concluded.

Classification for Classes A, B and C will be done using the total of the scores from Days One and Two, first 125 targets. Competitors will be ranked top score to lowest score. Classification A, B or C will be determined by dividing the competitors in approximate thirds starting with the top score.

PARTICIPATION WAIVER

This waiver is to be completed by and is only for the use of those participants and spectators who have reached and/or are over the age of majority and should be completed and signed prior to any payment and/or registration or facility entry for this Event.

I am aware that the 2026 Canadian National Trap/Skeet Championships (the “Event”) involves many inherent risks, dangers and hazards, including but not limited to the use and operation of firearms, personal physical injury in association with target shooting as a sport, possible negligence on the part of the event director and organizers, the event hosting venue, event officials and volunteers, coaches, other athletes and spectators.

I, as a participant who has reached and/or is over the age of majority, freely accept and fully assume all such risks, dangers, and hazards and the possibility of personal injury, property damage, or loss resulting from such dangers, risks, and hazards. In consideration of the Shooting Federation of Canada (SFC) allowing me to take part as manager, coach, volunteer or athlete, official or spectator in this Event, I hereby agree to waive my right to legal action as follows:

1. To assume and accept all risks, dangers and hazards in connection with my participation in, and/or travel to and from the Event;
2. To waive any and all claims that I may have against the competition director or organizers, The Shooting Federation of Canada, Ontario Olympic Trapshooting Association (OOTA), Toronto International Trap & Skeet Club Ltd.
