



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS SHOTGUN COUNCIL DIRECTOR POSITION

The Shooting Federation of Canada has a total of one Council Director position up for election:

- SHOTGUN Council Director (3-year term)

Election to be held at the 2026 Shooting Federation of Canada Annual Meeting.

Application deadline: July 15th, 2026

Nomination Guidelines:

- Nominees must be nominated by two current members in good standing of the SFC
- This application form is for Council Director nominations
- The nomination form must be completed in full by both the nominators and nominee
- Nomination must include a ONE-page maximum resume or bio

Director Eligibility Criteria

- must be a member in good standing of the Shooting Federation of Canada
- must be a minimum of 18 years of age
- must have the capacity under law to contract

Nominee Expectations

It is expected that the nominees will:

- Be willing to serve on the SFC Board of Directors, if elected
- Have read and agree to abide by the Code of Conduct and all other policies of the corporation, including the role of the Board as described in the Board mandate information provided.
- Complete Sport Integrity Canada's UCCMS consent & training as requested, if elected
- Complete a Criminal Record Check as requested, if elected

Council Director Position

- The SFC governance model includes a High Performance Program Director, 4 Council Directors (Rifle, Pistol, Shotgun, Provincial / Territorial Sport Organization (PTSO)) – collectively referred to as the Council Directors.
- The Council Director will be responsible to 1) sit on the SFC Board, 2) work with SFC to establish the respective Council, 3) Chair the respective Council, and 4) in collaboration with the respective stakeholder group, drive the direction and activity of the Council.

To nominate an individual for the above-mentioned positions, please fill out the following form and return it to the SFC by July 27th, 2026. All nominations require the signatures of two members of the corporation who are in good standing of the SFC. Memberships will be verified. If memberships are not in good standing, the nomination will be discarded.
